Mr. Raymond E. Hollenbach says-" Briggsville is the same as Mt. Zion Church of Nescopeck Township, and he had a Translation which he himself made from a photocopy of the original lent to him by Miss Bishop a number of years ago. This copy is a copy of Rev. A.S. Leiby's translation, and says" as is always the case in these translations from old German script there are a number of variations between Rev. Leiby's and his translations- due to poor writing and spelling in many instances. However on this copy is complete except on page 19 seven names are left out after Sameal Schmetter, in another respect this copy more complete, because the photocopy that he had had only 3 lists of communicants, and in his all the lists of communicants, beginning Nov. 19, 1811 (page 24) are missing. The reason for confusion of names is because the church was originally called "NESCOPECK CHURCH", but in the official records of the church minutes it is called "Mt. Zion Church". Locally it is known as BRIGGSVILLE.
