

Abstracts of Feme Covert Declarations for Chester County, Pennsylvania, 1832–1848

IN PENNSYLVANIA BEFORE 1848 a married woman (in legal terminology, a feme covert) could not directly receive money from land sales or partitions of estates by orphans' courts; she could only receive the money through her husband. One provision of a law passed by the Pennsylvania legislature in 1832 allowed a married woman to make a declaration to enable her husband to receive the money due to her on her behalf without posting any security.¹ Declarations of femes covert (married women) were filed in orphans' court during the period 1832–1848. These declarations link married women to estates to which they were heirs.

The 1832 law, which outlined the process to be used by orphans' courts to distribute shares of estates, stipulated the wording of the feme covert declaration:

I, A. B., the wife of C. B., am entitled to the sum of _____ proceeding from the sale (or partition) of the real estate of D. E., in the County of _____. Now, I do certify and declare, that I consent and agree that the same be paid to my husband, the said C. B., without any condition of security whatever. Witness my hand, this _____ day of _____ &c.

The wording of the witnessing judge's certificate was also specified in the law. The certificate, which included the husband's residence and occupation, stated that the judge had explained the declaration to the woman and that she freely made the declaration. An 1848 act

of the legislature permitted a married woman to own property in Pennsylvania in her own right, eliminating the need for the declaration.²

The declaration of feme covert was filed with other estate papers under the name of the decedent. The following abstracts of the declarations filed in the Chester County orphans' court provide a link between the woman who made the declaration and the decedent in whose estate file the declaration is located. The declarations are listed alphabetically by name of husband. The abstracts include the following information: names of husband and wife; name of decedent and date of estate in orphans' court; date (month and year) of the declaration; residence of the husband; and the husband's occupation. The decedent was the person to whom the married woman was an heir and may have been the woman's parent, sibling, or other family member. If the husband's residence was in Chester County, the township is given unless it was omitted on the declaration. Italics indicate places of residence not in Chester County. In the abstracts, non-Chester County residences are given as either a county (if in Pennsylvania) or a state. The abstracts include all known first declarations of femmes covert filed in Chester County. If there was more than one declaration by a woman referring to the same decedent's estate, only the first one is included in the abstracts.

The declarations are filed in orphans' court decedents' estates (accessed by the name and the date in the second column of these abstracts). Other records in decedents' estates may provide family information not included in the declaration abstracts. The original records are available to researchers at the Chester County Archives and Records Services in West Chester, Pennsylvania. The archives is administered by the Chester County Historical Society in cooperation with the County of Chester.
